FPK INVITES A MALAYSIAN PROFESSOR

Faculty of Fisheries and Marine (FPK) UNAIR invited a Malaysian professor Prof. Dr. Wan Maznah Wan Omar to give a guest lecture. In the lecture at Cakalang Building FPK, Tuesday, April 23, Prof. Maznah talked about Phycological Research for Sustainable Aquaculture.

Prof. Dr. Wan Maznah Wan Omar is a professor at School of Biological Sciences Universiti Sain Malaysia. She explained in the lecture that Phycological Research is one of the sciences which study about algae.

According to her, algae are very important in an ecological area since they function as the first autotrophic organism which builds food webs in waters. Moreover, macroalgae production for human consumption purposes in Asia, South America, and Africa is the most developed in aquaculture industry. (*)

FH COMPETES IN THE USA

From international level, an achievement which brings pride came from Faculty of Law (FH) UNAIR Team which represented Indonesia at Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition 2019 in Washington DC, from March 31 to April 7. FH UNAIR Team ranked 13th out of 130 countries which was an outstanding achievement since it was only their second time participating at the competition.

Dr. Intan Soepartha as the team coach explained that Phillip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition is the world's largest international competition on court simulation. Participation reaches more than 680 universities all over the world in this annual competition and each team has to pass a national selection before they represent their country at international level.

"The case for this year's moot court was Differences on Natural Resources between Two Countries. In the Preliminary Round, UNAIR Jessup Team left teams from Albania, Iran, China, and Chile behind after collecting the highest score. The Team then entered the top-32 round and successfully defeated Australian Team (University of Queensland) which was last year's winner," she said.

"In the top-16 round or Octo-final round, UNAIR Team competed against American Team (Yale University) and had to admit their opponent's winning which kept them from the next round. And for the first time, UNAIR Team entered the top-16 position and ranked 13th out of 130 countries," she added.

There were four UNAIR delegates who participated at Jessup 2019, namely Regine Wiranata (2016), Megawati Widjaja (2016), Shofy Suma Nisrina (2016), Thesalonica Shinta (2017) and Dr. Intan Soepartha as their coach. In the competition, UNAIR represented Indonesia for two consecutive years. (*)
