Have fun reading! Universitas Airlangga (UNAIR) held an inauguration for the latest 985 graduates on Saturday, June 29, led by the Rector, Prof. Nasih. Took place at Airlangga Convention Center (ACC) Campus C UNAIR, the ceremony went solemnly.

Inaugurated on that day were 49 graduates from Faculty of Medicine, 56 from Faculty of Law, 256 from Faculty of Economics and Business, 6 from Faculty of Pharmacy, 91 from Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, 84 from Faculty of Social and Political Sciences, 101 from Faculty of Science and Technology, 24 from Postgraduate School, 55 from Faculty of Public Health, 56 from Faculty of Psychology, 61 from Faculty of Humanities, 78 from Faculty of Nursing, 32 from Faculty of Fisheries and Marine, and 36 from Faculty of Vocational Studies.



Universitas Airlangga (UNAIR) inaugurated three new professors on Saturday, June 22, in Garuda Mukti Hall, Fifth Floor, UNAIR Rectorate Building. The three professors, who are from three different faculties, were Prof. Dr. Ernie Maduratna Setiawatie, drg., M.Kes., Sp.Perio(K) from Faculty of Dental Medicine (FKG), Prof. Dr. Widjiati, drh., M.Si., from Faculty of Veterinary Medicine (FKH), and Prof. Dr. Raditya Sukmana, S.E., M.A., from Faculty of Economics and Business (FEB).

In his speech, Rector Prof. Dr. Muhammad Nasih, S.E., MT., AK., CMA., said that the mission for the professors is to prosper the nation, so that every research and product they generate should be implemental and applicable as well as possible. By doing so, the professors will finally be able to give a real contribution to the alma mater and Indonesia.

> "We are hoping these three professors will keep putting efforts to develop science and stay keen so that they can invent better and more useful products for the people," he said. (*)

The Professors' Brilliant and Innovative Ideas

On their inauguration day, the three professors suggested some brilliant and innovative ideas that might be recommendations for the government in making public policy.

Prof. Dr. Ernie is recorded as the 20th active professor at FKG and the 479th since UNAIR was established. She is also the 187th inaugurated professor since the University received its State University–Legal Entity (PTN-BH) status. On the inauguration day, she delivered a scientific oration entitled Periodontal Medicine Era 4.0.

"Periodontal disease is preventable and in many cases the treatment is easy. Thus, there has to be dissemination on its preventive efforts," Prof. Ernie said.

Next is Prof. Dr. Widjiati, the 28th professor at FKH, the 480th since the establishment of UNAIR, and the 188th since the PTN-BH status. When inaugurated, she delivered a scientific oration entitled Mass Production Technology of Cow Embryos Era 4.0.

"It is time to think of another assisted reproductive technology besides artificial insemination to deal with the slow growth of cattle population," she revealed.

Meanwhile, Prof. Dr. Raditya was inaugurated as the 26th active professor at FEB, the 481st since UNAIR was founded, and the 189th under PTN-BH status. He delivered a scientific oration entitled Waqf and Development Era 4.0.

According to him, waqf nowadays has been expanding into many sectors, such as waqf at Sharia banks, stock markets, and Islamic insurance. Waqf is more than a "religious institution" that merely manages ritual matters. It can potentially be a "socio-economic institution" when its roles are optimally explored.

Waqf management should return to its origin, which means to manage waqf productively by working on its economic value added instead of conserving its assets and benefit. (*)

There were 667 participants from 27 countries in Asia, Europe, and the USA attended the event from 19 to 21 June 2019.

UNAIR Vice Rector II, Dr. Muhammad Madyan, S.E., M.Si., M.Fin., who opened the event said that the meeting for hundreds of management scientists around the world became a strategic step for the University to reinforce its international recognition.

Meanwhile, the Dean of Faculty of Economics and Business UNAIR, Prof. Dr. Dian Agustia, S.E., M.Si., Ak., said that the event, the first ever in Indonesia, was a prestigious one especially for experts in Management Science.

UNAIR Promotes Collaborations with Various Parties

Collaboration, partnerships, and cooperation between competent parties will speed up the process of achieving the goals. The results will be more optimal, as well. UNAIR is always open to cooperate with various parties. There have been numerous collaborations so far. Currently, lecturers at the Faculty of Science and Technology and Faculty of Medicine are doing collaborative research with lecturers from prominent universities in Indonesia.

UNAIR lecturers Riries R., S.T., M.T., with her team (Winarno, S.Si, M.T., Osmalina Nur Rahma, S.T., M.Si., Anny Setijo R., dr., SpPA (K), and Etty Hary Kusumastuti, dr., SpPA(K), FIAC). They are in collaboration with Dr. Eng. Kuwat Triyana (Gadjah Mada University), Prof. Andriyan Bayu S., Ph.D (Bandung Institute of Technology) and Dr. Imas Sukaesih, M.Kom (Bogor Institute of Agriculture)

The team is working on an innovative device called a Digital Pathology Virtual Microscope (DPVM) for Pap smear image screening to detect cervical cancer. The research will generate hardware and software tools. Not only function as early detection for patients, but the device will also serve as a learning tool for resident doctors. The device itself has been equipped with portable microscope; however, it is strengthened explicitly for cervical cancer.

Meanwhile, from 17 to 18 June 2019, Faculty of Pharmacy UNAIR cooperated with National University Singapore and held a seminar to update information on the development of the pharmaceutical industry.

Took place in Nanizar Zaman Joenoes Building Campus C UNAIR, the Pharmaceutical Technology Seminar 2019 aimed to bridge academics, manufacture industry, and pharmaceutical industry as well as to update information around tool design techniques, analysis, stability, and manufacturing process done at the industrial scale. FST Students Achieve Success in Thailand and China

Six students of Faculty of Science and Technology (FST) Universitas Airlangga (UNAIR) victoriously won six medals in the International Malaysia-Indonesia-Thailand Symposium on Innovation and Creativity 2019 (IMIT SIC 2019). Princess of Naradhiwas University, Thailand, hosted this international scale technology-based competition from June 16 to 18, 2019.

In the white elephants country, UNAIR delegation won one gold medal, four silver medals, and one bronze medal from six innovations they presented.

Difa Fanani Ismayanto won the gold medal with an innovation called Medical Device Innovation by Integrating Electrocardiograph, Expert System, and Visual Analogue Scale for the Detection of Acute Myocardial Infarction.

Four students won the silver medals, namely Affandy Fahrizain with Agri Tech: Agriculture Marketing for Millenial Farmers in Indonesia Based on Android. Bidayatul Mas'ulah with Go-Clever (Cleaning River) Application Based on Expert System (ES) as a Determination of the River Water Quality using Visual Basic 6.0. Next was Muhammad Fajar Faliasthiunus Pradipta with EYE-SEER (Eco-Friendly Speedbump Energy Resource. Muhamad Rizaldi B. Nuryasin won the last silver medal with his work called (SATE) Smart Magnetic Fishing Boat: Innovation on Efficient, Low-cost, and Environmentally Friendly Fishing Boats.

Finally, Zilvana Nurul Izza who won the bronze medal with Utilization of Turmeric as an Alternative Cancer Prevention through Kuper Candy (Kunyit Penghilang Resahmu – Your Turmeric Restless Relief)

Meanwhile, on May 17, Department of Chemistry, FST UNAIR successfully sent its best student to an international conference, "Asia Young Scholar Summit." Not only became a participant, but the student also had the opportunity to be a speaker and present her paper at Tianjin University, China.

Novia Faridatus Sholihah, also known as Nova, presented her paper "Development of Folic Acid-Based Carbon Nano-

dots for Synoptical Staining Agent of HeLa Tumor Cell" and won the Best Paper award in the conference.

"I analyze the ability of folic acid as the basic ingredient of carbon Nanodots to be the candidate for the bio-imaging agent in cancer cells," she explained. (*)
